Three-time defending girls cross country team wins FHSAA Fall Academic Team Champion Award

February 22, 2008, Jacksonville, Florida—Episcopal is pleased to announce that the Florida High School Athletic Association has awarded the Fall Academic Team Champion Award to Episcopal's three-time state championship girls cross country team. The program recognizes teams in each of the FHSAA's 20 sanctioned sports and 11 recognized sports, naming an Academic Team Champion in each classification.

Episcopal's class 2A team won the award for their impressive spring 2007 cumulative grade-point average of 3.946. The runner-up team for the competition cumulatively averaged a 3.872 GPA (West Shore in Melbourne, Florida). Girls cross country coach Michelle Krueger said of the honor, "I am thrilled that our girls received this recognition. They work so hard in everything they do, and I am proud to be able to coach such an amazing group of girls."
